Our Man in Bolivia! Dr Wayne Morris recently represented the Church of England at a convention organised by the World Council of Churches in La Paz, Bolivia. This was a consultation of theologians on the theme of Just and Inclusive Communities. It focussed on the concerns of four groups: people with disabilities, Dalit people from India, indigenous people and those combating racism. The agenda was to provide a theological vision for the WCC on Just and Inclusive Communities and to develop processes and strategies to work towards that vision. Wayne will speak about his experience in the sermon at Parish Communion on Sunday 17 June at 10.45 am.
