### **ELECTORAL ROLL – 2008**

The annual revision of the Electoral Roll starts on 2 March 2008. The present Roll was started in April 2007. If you have not already registered but wish to be included in this Roll, and have been worshipping at St James for the last six months, please submit a completed application form to Church or to Fiona Lee at The Rectory, Birch Heath Lane. Application forms are available from the back of Church.

As the Annual Parochial Church Meeting will take place on **Sunday 6 April 2008**, final entries for inclusion in the 2008 roll must be received no later than **19 March**.

### **Why should I register on the Electoral Roll?**

as a member of the congregation of St James it entitles you to vote

at the Annual Parochial Church Meeting. The Electoral Roll needs to be an accurate record of all those who worship at St James as it is the working document of the PCC, and is used in all calculations, planning etc.

If you live outside the Parish and wish to be married at St James, this is only possible if you are on the Electoral Roll through being a regular worshipping member.

A new grave in the churchyard is only available to those who, at the time of death, either lived in the Parish or were on the Electoral Roll.
