1. There have been numerous reports all week of youths throwing stones and windows being broken in the Church Lane area of Farndon. Police are aware of this ongoing issue and are currently undertaking several measures to tackle the problem and catch the offenders. Matters are progressing, but police need members of the public to phone in as soon as possible with accurate descriptions and if possible, names of those responsible.
2. Last Sunday night, a crane in Tilston Road, Malpas had several bits of damage caused to it overnight. Police would welcome any information from local residents who may have seen anything.
3. On Monday night, the electrical substation on Belle Vue Lane, Guilden Sutton was broken into again. It is only a week since this location was targeted. As well as being highly dangerous, the theft of metal has real potential to interrupt the electric supply to local residents. As such, police would welcome any information to help identify the offenders.
4. A historic building under renovation on High Street, Tarvin has had damage caused on Monday night. Do you know of anyone hanging around this location?
5. On Tuesday, horses were let out of a stable in Burton Lane, Duddon and attempts made to get them out of the field. Please ensure that your security of agricultural buildings is up to scratch to prevent thefts from isolated rural locations.
6. Registration plates were stolen from vehicles in Frodsham on Wednesday. Police have arrested two males for this offence. Prompt reporting of incidents and suspicious activity greatly assists police in achieving positive results.
7. On Thursday night, a shed was broken into in Grindley Brook. Did any local residents see or hear anything suspicious.
