



## Christleton/Littleton Monthly Update.

This is the newsletter for March 2013. The incidents of note are as follows.

An insecure shed was entered at Pepper Street, Christleton, and a Trek bike and power tools were stolen.

Police responded to a complaint of anti social behaviour on Village Road, Christleton. Youths had been throwing things at passing cars. Group were identified and spoken to. There was no damage to any vehicles and no evidence to suggest what had been thrown.

A male from the Christleton area has been arrested in connection with thefts of bikes from Chester city centre. This male has recently been stop checked in Waverton, by the shops. Please ensure bikes are always kept locked.

Police received a call reporting prowlers in the vicinity of 83 Tarvin Road, Littleton. Police conducted a search of the area and the prowlers were disturbed and made off across fields towards Cotton Edmunds and Tarvin. 2 males were subsequently arrested for going equipped to steal.

Suspicious male calling door to door in the Bridge Drive area of Christleton - caller has just had a male with an Irish accent knock on his door asking caller if he wants to buy some mattresses that were surplus to requirements at a B & B across the road. There is no B & B across the road, male in a white transit van HJ59 YLL - male described as 55 yrs - 60 yrs, slicked back hair, well built wearing a tweed jacket, 5 ft 9", male seemed to be alone. Road is a cul de sac direction of travel unknown.
