2. All baskets/containers/pots must be easily accessible for viewing. Please state location on entry form, eg. front of house, on patio, etc.
3. Baskets/containers/pots may be entered separately or as a group of two or more.
4. The judging will take place after 4th July, and the winners announced at the Show on 11th July.
5. No communication is to be entered into with the judges, whose decisions will be final.
